

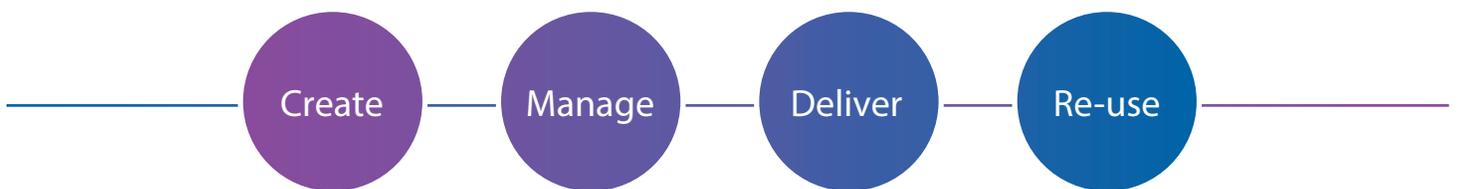

Structured Content Management (SCM).

By introducing SCM to your organization, traditional documents are split up into modular content that can be categorized into topics, tagged and then authored and approved individually. This content can be later pulled into different documents or other information sources or used on their own. This means **one question** gets **one answer**.

By creating information in this manner, content is written and approved only once, but automatically updated everywhere and every time a new document is published. Furthermore, it can be distributed both internally or externally in different languages and with potential local variations.

Ultimately, structured content is written once and reused across multiple channels in the organization, such as:

- MS Word and PDF documents
- apps
- intranet/extranets
- content search portals
- line-of-business systems
